8. Review of the performance of the Group

Financial performance (2QFY2019 vs 2QFY2018)

Group revenue for the quarter ended 31 December 2018 ("2QFY2019") totalled \$11.2 million, a decrease of 39.6% as compared to \$18.6 million in the corresponding period of the previous year ("2QFY2018"). Group revenue decreased as a result of streamlining of Group operations, resulting in reduction of revenue, whilst cost of sales and labour costs have also declined accordingly. Gross profit margin has increased by 11.4%, from 51.1% in 2QFY2018 to 62.5% in 2QFY2019, due to effective management of operations.

Streamlining of Group operations have also resulted in reductions in administrative expenses by 22.4%, from \$6.9 million in 2QFY2018 to \$5.4 million in 2QFY2019. Labour costs decreased by 14.0%, from \$5.0 million in 2QFY2018 to \$4.3 million in 2QFY2019. Other administrative expenses including depreciation charges and other expenses also declined.

Other operating expenses decreased by 3.2%, from \$2.8 milion in 2QFY2018 to \$2.7 million in 2QFY2019. Reductions in operating expenses have resulted in improved margins.

For 2QFY2019, Group loss before tax was \$0.47 million (as compared to Group profit before tax of \$0.12 million for 2QFY2018); and Group net loss after tax was \$0.52 million (as compared to Group net profit after tax of \$0.12 million for 2QFY2018).

Financial performance (1HFY2019 vs 1HFY2018)

Group revenue for the first half-year ended 31 December 2018 ("1HFY2019") totalled \$21.6 million, a decrease of 38.2% as compared to \$35.0 million in the corresponding period of the previous year ("1HFY2018"). Group revenue decreased as a result of streamlining of Group operations, resulting in reduction of revenue, whilst cost of sales and labour costs have also declined accordingly. Gross profit margin has increased by 11.6%, from 55.2% in 1HFY2018 to 66.8% in 1HFY2019, due to effective management of operations.

Streamlining of Group operations have also resulted in reductions in administrative expenses by 28.5%, from \$14.5 million in 1HFY2018 to \$10.4 million in 1HFY2019. Labour costs decreased by 18.4%, from \$10.3 million in 1HFY2018 to \$8.4 million in 1HFY2019. Other administrative expenses including depreciation charges and other expenses also declined.

Other operating expenses decreased by 0.8%, from \$5.70 milion in 1HFY2018 to \$5.65 million in 1HFY2019. Reductions in operating expenses have resulted in improved margins.

For 1HYF2019, Group loss before tax was \$0.39 million (as compared to Group profit before tax of \$0.39 million for 1HYF2018); and Group net loss after tax was \$0.44 million (as compared to Group net profit after tax of \$0.39 million for 1HFY2018).

Financial position of the Group

Group and Company cash and bank balances as at 31 December 2018 ("HY2019") stood at \$1.6 million and \$0.4 million respectively as compared to \$4.1 million and \$1.3 million respectively as at 30 June 2018 ("FY2018"). The Group continues its efforts to grow its businesses, including partnering with potential strategic business partners, both locally and globally, for both raw materials supply as well as in business expansion. The Group continues to be cautious and will take reasonable steps to manage its cash flow effectively.

Total trade payables increased by 29.3%, from \$4.1 million in FY2018 to \$5.3 million in HY2019. Other payables and accruals as well as provisions of the Group have decreased by 22.4%, from \$4.9 million in FY2018 to \$3.8 million in HY2019, following the streamlining of food & beverage businesses.

Total Group and Company bank loan balances have declined due to the repayment of term loans over the period.

Shareholders' equity for the Group and Company stood at \$42.8 million and \$26.6 million respectively as at HY2019, as compared with \$41.7 million and \$28.1 million respectively as at FY2018.

Cash flow of the Group

The Group had operating cash flows of \$0.1 million in 2QFY2019, which has improved from negative of \$8.6 million as at 2QFY2018.

The Group had negative operating cash flows of \$1.2 million in 1HFY2019, which has improved from that of \$5.9 million as at 1HFY2018.

The Group will continue to be cautious and take reasonable steps to ensure the continuous growth in the operations and managing its operating costs effectively.

Matters concerning GREIH & GCM

The Company had previously, by way of an announcement on 2 July 2018, provided an update on the outcome of Suit 122, Suit 1098, Suit 1099, Suit 969, CA 87 and CA 86 ("collectively "the legal proceedings").

Pursuant to the outcome of the legal proceedings, the liquidation of Griffin Real Estate Investment Holdings Pte. Ltd. ("GREIH") is on-going, including the adjudication of creditors' claims against GREIH and also the recovery of assets from relevant parties, including under Suit No. HC/S1116/2018 ("said suit"). In the said suit, one of the Defendants, TYN Investment Pte. Ltd. f. k.a. ERC International Pte. Ltd ("TYNI") have joined our Chairman, Mr. Douglas Foo Peow Yong ("Mr Foo"), in his personal capacity, as a third party, to claim contribution or indemnity from Mr Foo, in the event that TYNI is held liable to the Liquidators of GREIH. The third party joinder of Mr Foo does not materially affect the Company's business operations.

The Company will provide the necessary update upon notification of any material development by the Liquidators of GREIH concerning the recovery process pursuant to the legal proceedings.

Matters concerning sugar trade business

As the Company previously announced on 7 and 21 September 2018, in matters pertaining to the sugar trade business, the Company has since filed a police report in September 2018. Investigations are still on-going and in light of the same, the Company will provide further updates as and when it is appropriate to do so.

The Group continues to work hard to manage the challenging operating conditions in the Food & Beverage industry.
